2015 is also the 75th anniversary of the Battle of Britain. To mark both the Battle itself and Wiltshire's contribution to Spitfire production, a varied programme of events will take place during Salisbury Wings Week in September.

To top it all, Salisbury has been named by Lonely Planet as one of the Top 10 Cities in the world for travellers in 2015.

**Morning:** Start the day in the riverside setting of **Wilton Shopping Village** with its outlet shops, choice of cafés and free on-site coach parking then travel on to the stylish and cosmopolitan town of **Marlborough**.

#### Lunch: Marlborough.

Afternoon: As well as an array of high quality shops, this charming market town is home to The Merchant's House, where ongoing conservation makes for a very special visit, and St Peter's Church – a great place for refreshments and crafts. Then continue on to Swindon to visit the McArthurGlen Designer Outlet. Here you will find over 90 stores selling a range of high street and designer labels at up to 60% off RRP. Stores include LK Bennett, Kurt Geiger, Superdry, John Lewis Home, Ted Baker, Marks and Spencer, Hobbs plus many more.



#### In the Footsteps of Jane Austen

Morning: Relax in the tranquil setting of **Stourhead** garden, the location for the famous scene between Mr Darcy and Elizabeth Bennet in the 2005 film of Pride and Prejudice.

#### Lunch: At Stourhead or Wilton.

Afternoon: Visit Wilton House, the home of the Earl of Pembroke, which doubled as Pemberley, family seat of Mr Darcy. Then call in at **Mompesson House**, within Salisbury's Cathedral Close, which represented Mrs Jennings' London residence in the film of Sense and Sensibility. If you are able to extend your tour, several of the attractions in Bath have Jane Austen connections.

#### Along the Way

Buildings in the care of **The Churches Conservation Trust** make interesting stopping off points as you travel around Wiltshire.

#### **Castles and Hill Forts**

**Morning:** Start the day at the 11th century remains of **Ludgershall Castle**. From here it is just a short drive, via the garrison town of Tidworth, to the Iron Age hill fort of **Old Sarum**, on the northern edge of Salisbury, where you can see the ruins of a castle, cathedral and royal palace.

#### Lunch: Wilton or Tisbury.

Afternoon: First stop this afternoon is at the unusual 14th century hexagonal ruins of **Old Wardour Castle**. An audio tour brings its long history and dramatic involvement in the Civil War to life. Then it's on to the hidden treasures of another English Heritage property, 14th century **Farleigh Hungerford Castle** near Bradford on Avon. If you have time en route, the **Three Daggers** pub, brewery and farm shop makes a refreshing stopping off point.

#### **Discover Devizes**

**Morning:** At **Wadworth Brewery Visitor Centre** you can take a tour of the brewery, learn about the traditional methods of brewing, sign writing and sample some ales.

#### Lunch: Devizes.

Afternoon: Visit Wiltshire Museum with its new Saxon Gallery and gold from the time of Stonehenge. Make time to explore the town with its many independent, family run shops, or enjoy a leisurely barge trip on the Kennet & Avon Canal. Don't miss the flight of 29 consecutive locks at Caen Hill, on the edge of the town.

#### **Spectacular Salisbury**

Morning: Start your day with a tour of **Salisbury Cathedral**, a breathtaking example of Early English Gothic architecture. The Chapter House contains the finest of four original 1215 Magna Carta manuscripts. Stop off for elevenses at one of the cafés in the Cathedral Close, before visiting any of the other attractions there: **The Salisbury Museum**, **The Rifles Berkshire & Wiltshire Museum**, **Arundells or Mompesson House**.

#### Lunch: Salisbury.

Afternoon: Pay a visit to another of the Close attractions. Then head into the city centre with its range of unique, independent shops. Fisherton Mill with its gallery, café and artist studios is well worth a visit and on Tuesdays and Saturdays the Charter Market will be in full swing (except the third Tuesday in October). For those able to stay on into the evening, City Hall, Salisbury Arts Centre and Salisbury Playhouse offer excellent entertainment.

Morning: Thanks to its historic involvement in the production of woollen cloth, **Trowbridge** is home to rare textile-related architecture, while **Trowbridge Museum** contains a nationally important collection of related items, including working looms. Weaving demonstrations and hand loom sessions can be pre-booked.

#### Lunch: Melksham area.

Afternoon: Start the afternoon with a visit to the Lady Margaret Hungerford Almshouses and Schoolroom in the charming market town of Corsham. Then continue on to the nearby riverside town of Chippenham where the Chippenham Museum and Heritage Centre, housed in a fine 18th century building, tells the story of the town from prehistoric times until the present day. If you have a little longer, Royal Wootton Bassett Museum, the Royal Signals Museum and Whitchurch Silk Mill are also well worth a visit.



#### Magna Carta in Wiltshire

2015 marks the 800th anniversary of the signing of Magna Carta. Sealed by King John at Runnymede in June 1215, this 'great charter' went on to influence constitutional thinking and human rights in over 100 countries around the world.

#### Dav 1

Morning: Celebrate the 800th anniversary by viewing the best preserved of four original 1215 documents, housed in the Chapter House at Salisbury Cathedral. A special new exhibition showcasing Magna Carta opens in February 2015 and a programme of related events is scheduled as part of the year long celebrations.

#### Lunch: Salisbury city centre.

Afternoon: The Cathedral Close offers a wealth of other fascinating attractions, including Arundells, home of former Prime Minister Sir Edward Heath, the National Trust's Mompesson House, The Salisbury Museum housing world-class archaeological galleries, and The Rifles Berkshire & Wiltshire Museum.

**Overnight:** Salisbury or Amesbury.

#### Day 2

Morning: Just 20 minutes from Salisbury, the World Heritage Site of Stonehenge is one of the most famous monuments in the world. Believed to date from around 3,000 BC its orientation on the rising and setting sun is one of its many outstanding features, but why it was built in the way remains a mystery to this day. Then continue west to Trowbridge. The surrounding Stonehenge Landscape contains other ancient monuments such as King Barrow Ridge and Durrington Walls.

#### Lunch: Trowbridge.

Afternoon: Trowbridge, Wiltshire's county town, is also a Baron Town. One of its most famous sons, Henry de Bohun, was one of the 25 barons elected to enforce Magna Carta in the early 13th century. He is pictured in a stained glass window in St James Church, holding a copy of the Charter. A variety of Magna Carta-themed events will take place during 2015.

Then move on to stately **Corsham Court** where in 1760 he undertook the landscaping of the grounds, planting specimen trees and creating the ha ha, Great Walk and lake.

#### Lunch: Corsham or Lacock areas.

Afternoon: Spend the afternoon at nearby Bowood, where Capability Brown created a flowing mix of woodlands and lawns sloping down to a winding lake - a fitting setting for the magnificent 18th century house designed by Robert Adam.

#### Overnight: Devizes or Trowbridge areas.

#### Dav 2

Morning: The focus for this morning is 16th century **Longleat House**, an outstanding example of high Elizabethan architecture surrounded by 900 acres of stunning 'Capability' Brown landscaped parkland.

Lunch: Warminster or Wilton areas

Afternoon: Travel south and west to Wilton House. Bordered by the rivers Nadder and Wylye, the 21 acres of landscaped parkland owe much to master landscaper Capability Brown.
